Danny Quah is Head of Department and Professor of Economics at The London School of Economics and Political Science.

Professor Quah obtained his PhD from Harvard University and his AB from Princeton University. He joined LSE in 1991 after having taught as an assistant professor in MIT's Economics Department. In the UK, he has served on the Academic Panels of HM Treasury and the Office for National Statistics. He is a Research Fellow at the Centre for Economic Policy Research in London and a Governor of the National Institute of Economic and Social Research. His current research is on growth and inequality, and technology and intellectual property rights.
